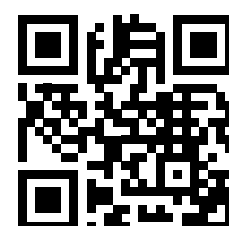

Takriban Wakenya milioni 31.5 sasa wamejisajiliwa chini ya Mamlaka ya Afya ya Jamii (SHA) huku serikali ikiongeza kasi ya mageuzi yanayolenga kupanua upatikanaji wa huduma za afya nafuu kote nchini. Akizungumza wakati wa kongamano la kuwawezesha wawendeshabodaboda katika viwanja vya Chuo cha Mafunzo ya Ualimu cha Kericho, Waziri wa Afya Aden Duale alisema kiwango hicho cha usajili kinaonyesha imani inayoongezeka ya wananchi

kwa mfumo mpya wa ufadhili wa huduma za afya. Alibainisha kuwa Kaunti ya Kericho tayari imesajili wakazi zaidi ya 450,000, na hivyo kuwa miongoni mwa kaunti zinazoongoza kitaifa. mana na maafisa wengine wa serikali, pia alichangisha Shilingi milioni 15 kwa ajili ya miradi ya maendeleo ya miundombinu katika Parokia ya Kikatoliki ya Mtakatifu Ambrose Kabeo, huku akizungumza na wakazi kuhusu mipango ya serikali chini

ya Ajenda ya Mageuzi ya Kiu-chumi ya Bottom-Up (BETA). Wadau wa sekta ya afya katika Kaunti ya Kwale wanaongeza juhudi za kupunguza vifo vya kina mama wajawazito kupitia kuhimiza mahudhuro ya mapema ya kliniki za wajawazito, kuongeza uhamasishaji kuhusu uzazi wa mpango, kutoa elimu ya afya kwa jamii na kuhimiza ushiriki mkubwa wa wanaume katika huduma za afya ya uzazi. Kwa mujibu wa maafisa wa afya, Kaunti ya Kwale ilirekodi vifo 28 vya kina mama wajawazito katika mwaka wa kifedha wa 2024/2025. Kati ya Januari na Juni 2025, vifo

Wataalamu wa afya wanaeleza kuwa vifo vingi vinatokana na matatizo yanayoweza kuzuilika, yakiwemo kutokwa na damu nyingi baada ya kuji-fungua na shinikizo la damu linalosababishwa na ujauzito. Ili kukabiliana na changamoto hiyo, Shirika la Fanikisha Foundation, kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Afya ya Kaunti ya Kwale, limekuwa likiendesha mijadala ya kijamii kwa lengo la kuelimisha familia kuhusu afya ya uzazi, uzazi wa mpango, lishe bora na chanjo za watoto.

Waziri huyo alisema SHA inaleta mageuzi makubwa katika utoaji wa huduma za afya kwa kuondoa vikwazo vya kifedha ambavyo kwa muda mrefu vimezuia familia nyingi kupata matibabu. Aliongeza kuwa mfumo huo umejengwa juu ya misingi ya usawa na uendelevu katika ufadhili wa huduma za afya. Duale pia alitangaza hatua kubwa ya kuimarisha huduma za afya ya uzazi, akifichua kuwa serikali imetenga Shilingi bilioni 4 kugharamia kikamilifu huduma za uzazi katika hospitali za umma, hatua itakayowawezesha wajawazito kujifungua salama bila kulipia gharama za matibabu. “Hatua hii inahakikisha kila mama anajifungua kwa heshima na usalama. Hakuna mwanamke anayepaswa kuwa na wasiwasi kuhusu bili za hospitali katika wakati muhimu wa kuleta maisha duniani. Serikali imeamua kuondoa mzigo huo kwa kugharamia kikamilifu huduma za uzazi,” alisema. Alisema sera hiyo pia inatarajiwa kupunguza kwa kiwango kikubwa vifo vya akina mama na watoto wachanga kwa kuwahamasisha wajawazito wengi zaidi kujifungulia katika vituo rasmi vya afya vinavyotoa huduma za kitaalamu. Aidha, Duale alithibitisha kuwa huduma za afya ya misingi zime-

fadhiliwa kikamilifu chini ya mageuzi yanayoendelea, akizitaja kuwa misingi wa huduma za kinga na ugunduzi wa mapema wa magonjwa katika mfumo wa Huduma za Afya kwa Wote (UHC). Katika hatua nyingine ya kuimarisha miundombinu ya afya Kericho, Duale alitangaza kuwa kaunti hiyo itapokea mashine ya Magnetic Reso-

nance Imaging (MRI), hatua inayotarajiwa kupunguza rufaa za wagonjwa kwenda Eldoret na hospitali nyingine za mbali. “Mashine hii ya MRI italeta huduma maalumu za uchunguzi karibu zaidi na wananchi wa Kericho. Itapunguza ucheleweshaji wa utambuzi wa magonjwa, kupunguza gharama za usafiri kwa wagonjwa na kui-

marisha uwezo wa kaunti kushughulikia visa tata vya matibabu hapa hapa nyumbani,” alieleza. Pia alifichua kuwa Shilingi bilioni 9.8 zimetengwa kuwaajiri wafanyakazi 7,740 wa mpango wa Huduma za Afya kwa Wote (UHC) kwa masharti ya kudumu na yanayowapa haki ya pensheni. Alisema mashauriano na taasisi muhimu za serikali yako katika

hatua za mwisho kabla ya kuwajiri rasmi ifikapo mwezi Julai. Kuhusu ufadhili wa sekta ya afya, Duale alisema serikali tayari imelipa Shilingi bilioni 4 za madai yaliyokuwa yamesalia ya Hazina ya Kitaifa ya Bima ya Afya (NHIF), huku malipo mengine yaliyothibitishwa yakiendelea kushughulikiwa katika bajeti ya sasa. Aliwahakikishia watoa huduma za afya kuwa serikali itaendelea kuhakikisha uthabiti wa kifedha katika utoaji wa huduma. Mbali na sekta ya afya, alitaja hatua nyingine za serikali, zikiwemo kupunguza bei ya mbolea kutoka Shilingi 7,000 hadi Shilingi 2,500, kuajiri walimu zaidi ya 100,000 na kujenga zaidi ya vibanda 600,000 vya masoko kote nchini ili kuwawezesha wafanyabiashara wadogo. “Hatua hizi si mafanikio ya pekee bali ni sehemu ya mkakati wa kitaifa unaolenga kuimarisha kipato cha familia, kungeza uzalishaji na kuhakikisha ukuaji wa uchumi unawanufaisha wananchi katika ngazi ya mashinani,” alisema Duale. Aliwahimiza Wakenya kujisajili katika SHA kupitia nambari *147#, akisema mpango huo unalinda familia dhidi ya gharama kubwa za matibabu na kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa huduma muhimu za afya, ikiwemo huduma za uzazi. “Kila Mkenya aliyesajiliwa anahakikishiwa ulinzi wa kifedha anapotafuta huduma za afya,” alisema.

NATIONAL VALIDATION ON THE PROPOSED ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION AND TRACEABILITY BILL, 2026

The Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock Development, through the State Department for Livestock Development, has developed the Draft Animal Identification and Traceability Bill, 2026.

The Bill seeks to provide a legal framework for the identification and traceability of animals and animal products, establish systems for animal identification, registration and traceability, and support the surveillance, control and eradication of animal diseases.

Following the nationwide stakeholder engagement and public participation exercise conducted in April 2026, the draft Bill has been revised to incorporate stakeholder comments and recommendations. The National Validation Meeting has been convened to present the revised Bill and obtain final stakeholder input before submission for further legislative processing.

In line with the Constitution of Kenya and the principles of public participation, the Ministry invites stakeholders, members of the public, and all interested parties to attend the National Validation Meeting and provide their views on the proposed legislation.

Kaunti sita za ukanda wa Pwani zimezindua mpango wa uchumi wa buluu wenye thamani ya Sh156 bilioni (Dola za Marekani bilioni 1.2) unaolenga kuunda nafasi za ajira, kuimarisha ustahimilivu dhidi ya mabadiliko ya tabianchi na kukuza ustawi wa pamoja kwa jamii za pwani katika kipindi cha miaka minne ijayo. Mpango wa Utekelezaji wa Mashirika Mbalimbali wa Uchumi wa Buluu wa Jumuiya ya Kaunti za Pwani (JKP-BEMAP) 2026-2030 ulizinduliwa mjini Mombasa wakati wa kufungwa kwa Kongamano la Our Ocean. Mpango huo unaziunganisha serikali za

kaunti, mashirika ya kitaifa na washirika wa maendeleo chini ya ramani moja ya uwekezaji. Mwenyekiti wa Jukwaa la Magavana wa Jumuiya ya Kaunti za Pwani (JKP), Dhadho Godhana, alisema mpango huo uliandaliwa baada ya mashauriano ya kina yaliyowahusisha wananchi wa maeneo ya pwani, serikali za kaunti na wataalamu wa sekta mbalimbali, na utatoa mwongozo wa ajenda ya uchumi wa buluu wa eneo hilo kwa miaka minne ijayo. “Mpango huu umehusisha jamii zote, kaunti zote, timu zote za wataalamu hadi kwa magavana. Leo tumekuja kuidhinisha rasmi kama mpango wa utekelezaji wa programu zetu kama jumuiya

ya kaunti za pwani,” alisema. Gavana wa Kaunti ya Tana River alisema pia kuwa jumuiya hiyo imeanzisha Hatifungani ya Bluu-Kijani (Blue-Green Bond) inayolenga kukusanya karibu Dola za Marekani milioni 400 ili kupunguza utegemezi kwa Serikali ya Kitaifa na kuweka msingi endelevu wa ufadhili wa miradi ya maendeleo ya pwani. “Suala si kuhusu kile ambacho wengine wamefanya. Linategemea kile tunachotaka kufanikisha. Ni kuhusu namna tunavyofanikisha maendeleo hayo,” alisema Godhana huku akizihimiza Vitengo vya Usimamizi wa Fukwe (Beach Management Units - BMUs), vyama vya

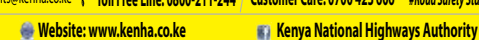

Msukumo wa utawala walenga kuziba pengo la kijinsia katika umiliki wa ardhi

Idara ya Serikali ya Ardhi na Mipango ya Kimwili, kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Serikali ya Masuala ya Jinsia na Hatua za Utekelezaji Maalum kupitia Mpango wa Msaada wa Miji nchini Kenya (KUSP), inaongoza mpango kabambe wa kuanzisha mifumo ya usimamizi wa ardhi inayozingatia usawa wa kijinsia. Kupitia kuimarisha haki za wanawake za kumiliki ardhi—ikiwemo kufanya ridhaa ya mwenzi wa ndoa kuwa hitaji la kisheria katika uhamishaji wa umiliki wa vipande vya ardhi na kuhakikisha wanawake wanawakilishwa kwa usawa katika Kamati za Usimamizi wa Ardhi ya Jamii—mpango huo unalenga kushughulikia ukosefu wa usawa uliodumu kwa muda mrefu na kuimarisha uwezesaji wa wanawake kiuchumi. Mkurugenzi Msaaidizi wa Uamuzi wa Umiliki na Makazi ya Ardhi na pia Afisa wa Masuala ya Jinsia wa idara hiyo, Joyce Kamire, alisema kuwa licha ya Kenya kuwa na mfumo thabiti wa sheria kuhusu haki za ardhi, wanawake bado wanakum-

bana na vikwazo vikubwa katika kumiliki na kudhibiti ardhi. “Wanawake wa maeneo ya vijijini wanachangia karibu robo tatu ya nguvu kazi katika sekta ya kilimo, lakini wanamiliki chini ya asilimia tano ya ardhi,” alisema Kamire, akisisitiza pengo lililopo kati ya matakwa ya sheria na hali halisi. Alibainisha kuwa juhudi za kuziba pengo hilo tayari zimeanza kuzaa matunda katika Kaunti ya Turkana, ambapo wakazi wa vijiji kadhaa vya Kakuma hivi karibuni walishiriki katika zoezi la uhamasishaji kuhusu usajili wa ardhi chini ya mpango wa KUSP. Alisema mpango huo umeimarisha usimamizi wa ardhi na kuendeleza maendeleo shirikishi katika eneo hilo, huku pia ukiwezesha uchaguzi wa Kamati za Usimamizi wa Ardhi ya Jamii. “Zoezi la uhamasishaji la Kakuma linaonyesha jinsi ushiriki wa jamii unavyoweza kuwa msingi wa maendeleo jumuishi na kuhakikisha wanawake, vijana na watu wanaoishi na ulemavu hawaachwi nyuma,” alisema Kamire. Alirejelea takwimu za Utafiti wa Afya ya Idadi ya Watu na Demografia wa Kenya wa



Mpango wa Usaidizi wa Miji wa Kenya (KUSP), unaongoza ajenda ya ujasiri ya kutekeleza mifumo ya usimamizi wa ardhi inayozingatia jinsia katika Kaunti ya Turkana.

mwaka 2022 zilizoonyesha hali ya kurudi nyuma, ambapo asilimia 75 ya wanawake hawamiliki ardhi ya kilimo ikilinganishwa na asilimia 61.3 mwaka 2014. “Ukosefu huu wa usawa unaeendeleza umaskini na kutengwa kwa wanawake, hasa wale wa maeneo ya vijijini,” alisisitiza Kamire. Kamire alisema changamoto kubwa katika utekelezaji na ufuatiliaji wa sheria hizi ni ukosefu wa takwimu rasmi, sahihi na za kisasa kuhusu umiliki wa ardhi kwa wanawake. “Bila takwimu rasmi na za kuanzishwa, hatuwezi kuwawajibisha taasisi wala kubuni hatua madhubuti za kushughulikia

changamoto hizi,” alieleza. Ili kukabiliana na changamoto hiyo, Kamire alisema Idara ya Serikali ya Ardhi na Mipango ya Kimwili kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Serikali ya Masuala ya Jinsia na Hatua za Utekelezaji Maalum inapendekeza mpango wa kiufundi wenye athari kubwa chini ya KUSP utakaotumia miundombinu ya kidijitali ya serikali. Alisema mfumo wa ArdhiSasa utakuwa msingi wa utungaji sera unaotegemea ushahidi wa wakati halisi, huku ukiboresha ili kukusanya takwimu za umiliki wa ardhi zilizogawanywa kwa jinsia kila mwaka. amire alisema ubunifu huo unatoa jukwaa muhimu la kuharakisha usawa wa kijinsia kwa kushughulikia umaskini, kuimarisha taasisi na kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa rasilimali na ufadhili kwa usawa kwa kuzingatia masuala ya jinsia. “Tunataka kuondokana na utegemezi wa tafti zinazofan-

ywa mara chache na kuelekea katika mfumo endelevu wa takwimu rasmi,” alifafanua. Kamire alisisitiza kuwa kati ya wajumbe 15 wanaoahaguliwa kuunda Kamati za Usimamizi wa Ardhi ya Jamii, wasiopungua watano lazima wawe wanawake, huku pia kukiwa na uwakilishi sawa katika sekretarieti pamoja na uwakilishi wa watu wanaoishi na ulemavu na vijana. “Uwiano sawa wa wanawake katika kamati za usimamizi wa ardhi ya jamii si jambo la hiari bali ni hitaji la kishe-ria,” alisisitiza. Alieleza kuwa zoezi hilo ni sehemu ya juhudi pana za Awamu ya Pili ya KUSP zinazolenga kuunga mkono maendeleo endelevu ya mijini, kuimarisha ushiriki wa jamii na kuboresha mifumo ya usimamizi wa ardhi katika maeneo ambayo hayajapata huduma za kutosha nchini.

Mpango huo utatekelezwa katika sehemu za mtandao wa umeme nchini zinazopita kwenye njia za wanyamapori, kwa ushirikiano na kampuni ya Kaddas Enterprises yenye makao nchini Marekani. nchi. Kenya imepata haki ya kuwa mwenyeji wa Mkutano wa Nne wa Responsible AI in the Military Domain (REAIM) mwaka 2027, hatua inayodhihirisha kuongezeka kwa ushawishi wa nchi katika diplomasia ya teknolojia duniani na mijadala ya usalama wa kimataifa. Tangazo hilo lilitolewa katika Mkutano wa AI, Security and Ethics unaohusishwa na Umoja wa Mataifa uliofanyika Geneva, na Mjumbe Maalum wa Kenya kuhusu Teknolojia, Balozi Philip Thigo, aliyemwakilisha Waziri wa Ulinzi Soipan Tuya. Mkutano huo umepangwa kufanyika Aprili 2027 jijini Nairobi, na kuifanya Kenya kuwa nchi ya kwanza barani Afrika kuwa mwenyeji wa kongamano hilo maarufu duniani. Mikutano ya

awali imefanyika nchini Uholanzi, Korea Kusini na Hispania. Mkutano wa REAIM unatambuliwa kama moja ya majukwaa makuu duniani ya kujadili matumizi ya kuwajibika ya akili mnemba (AI) katika shughuli za

kijeshi. Huleta pamoja serikali, taasisi za ulinzi, kampuni za teknolojia, watafiti na wataalamu wa sheria za kimataifa kujadili teknolojia zinazoitambua na kuandaa sera za kuhakikisha zinatumiwa kwa uwajibikaji.

Miongoni mwa masuala yanayotarajiwa kutawala ajenda ya mkutano wa Nairobi ni usimamizi wa mifumo ya silaha zinazojiendesha zenyewe, matumizi ya mashine zinazojifunza (machine learning) katika operesheni za kijeshi, maamuzi yanayotolewa kwa kutumia algoriti vitani, pamoja na viwango vya kimataifa vya matumizi salama na yenye uwajibikaji ya teknolojia za AI katika sekta ya ulinzi. Ushindi wa Kenya wa kuandaa mkutano huo unakuja wakati dunia inaendelea kujadili kwa kina kasi ya maendeleo ya akili mnemba katika sekta za ulinzi na usalama. Majadiliano katika Mkutano wa Tatu wa REAIM uliofanyika A Coruña, Hispania, yalibainisha ugumu wa kufikiwa kwa mwafaka wa kimataifa, ambapo nchi 40 pekee kati ya 85 zilizohiriki zilizoidhinisha mfumo wa mwisho wa "Pathways to Action."

Wachambuzi wanasema ushindani unaoongezeka wa kisiasa kati ya mataifa makubwa na mitazamo tofauti kuhusu matumizi ya AI katika masuala ya kijeshi unaendelea kuwa kikwazo katika kuweka kanuni zinazokubalika kimataifa. Kuchaguliwa kwa Kenya kunatarajiwa kuiweka Nairobi kama jukwaa lisiloegemea upande wowote ambapo mataifa yenye maslahi tofauti ya kinkakati yanaweza kushiriki mazungumzo yenye tija na kuimarisha ushirikiano kuhusu usimamizi wa matumizi ya kuwajibika ya akili mnemba. Balozi Thigo, ambaye hivi karibuni alitambuliwa na taasisi ya Apolitical miongoni mwa viongozi wa kimataifa katika usimamizi wa AI, alisema mkutano wa mwaka 2027 utalenga kubadili mijadala kuwa hatua za vitendo. Alisema ajenda ya mkutano itatoa kipaumbele kwa kujenga uwezo wa kikanda, kutathmini utayari wa taasisi za ulinzi, pamoja na kuandaa viwango vya ushirikiano kati ya sekta ya umma na binafsi katika ununuzi wa teknolojia kwa njia ya uwajibikaji.

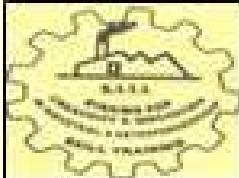

NLC DEVELOPS GUIDE FOR THE PREPARATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF LAND USE AND MANAGEMENT PLANS FOR LAND HELD BY PUBLIC AGENCIES

A NEW ERA IN THE SUSTAINABLE MANAGEMENT OF PUBLIC LAND

The National Land Commission (NLC) has developed the Guide for the Preparation and Implementation of Land Use and Management Plans (LUMPs) for Land Held by Public Agencies, establishing a uniform national framework for planning, developing, utilising and safeguarding public land across Kenya.

Developed under Article 67(2)(a) and (h) of the Constitution, Section 17 of the Land Act, 2012, and Legal Notice No. 280 of 2017, the Guide provides public agencies with a practical roadmap for preparing 20-year Land Use and Management Plans and submitting them to the National Land Commission for approval. It marks a major milestone in Kenya's land governance reforms, advancing the constitutional requirement that public land be managed equitably, efficiently, productively and sustainably.

Why the Guide Matters

Public land is among Kenya's most valuable national assets but has long faced challenges including land grabbing, encroachment, underutilisation, fragmented planning, competing land uses and weak management systems. These have resulted in loss of public assets, land disputes, environmental degradation and missed development opportunities.

The Guide addresses these challenges by standardising how public institutions prepare and implement Land Use and Management Plans, ensuring public land is protected, optimally utilised and aligned with national development priorities.

What is a LUMP?

A Land Use and Management Plan is a GIS-based, site-specific planning document prepared for public land under Section 17 of the Land Act. Each plan covers a 20-year period and is reviewed every five years to respond to emerging development and environmental needs.

LUMPs are designed to prevent land grabbing and encroachment, eliminate conflicting land uses, optimise public assets, reduce disputes, protect environmentally sensitive and culturally significant areas, safeguard land reserved for strategic projects and promote climate resilience.

Guiding Principles

The Guide promotes sustainable land management, transparency, accountability, efficiency, environmental conservation, economic optimisation of public assets, conflict prevention, inclusive public participation and equitable access to social and economic benefits. It is intended for public agencies, State corporations, National and County Government institutions, planning professionals, development partners, professional bodies, non-state actors and the public.

Preparing a LUMP

The Guide outlines a structured process that can be completed within six months. A public agency first resolves to prepare a LUMP, notifies the National Land Commission and engages a consortium led by a registered physical and land use planner.

Planning professionals then undertake data collection, site analysis, mapping and preparation of draft proposals through stakeholder engagement and public participation. The completed plan is adopted by the public agency before submission to the National Land Commission for approval upon recommendation by the relevant planning authority. The Commission is expected to conclude the approval process within 30 days.

What Every LUMP Must Contain

Every LUMP must include an agency profile and land inventory, planning context, land ownership details, existing land use analysis, proposed developments, GIS-based maps, environmental and social considerations, implementation strategies, monitoring and evaluation frameworks, and supporting technical documentation. Each report must also contain an executive summary, planning methodology, situational analysis and an implementation programme certified by registered planning professionals.

Implementation and Oversight

The National Land Commission serves as the approving authority, providing oversight, monitoring and compliance enforcement. Public agencies are responsible for preparing, implementing and managing approved plans, while planning authorities review plans, ensure compliance with planning standards and provide technical recommendations.

Every public agency must also prepare a Land Management Plan covering environmental safeguards, legal compliance, infrastructure maintenance, risk management, dispute resolution, land security and protection of public land boundaries. Agencies must maintain land for its approved purpose, obtain Commission approval before changing land use and comply with county planning requirements.

The National Land Commission will monitor implementation through site inspections, compliance reporting, performance monitoring and, where necessary, satellite imagery and drone technology to ensure developments conform to approved plans.

Transforming Public Land Management

The Guide provides public institutions with a practical framework for protecting strategic public assets, preventing illegal acquisition, promoting orderly development and reducing land-related disputes. By standardising planning procedures, strengthening institutional accountability and enhancing oversight, it supports sustainable development and ensures public land is managed prudently, efficiently and responsibly for the benefit of present and future generations.

The Commission's mandate to monitor and exercise oversight over land use planning is inseparable from the planning process itself. Effective oversight presupposes the existence of well-prepared plans that provide clear benchmarks for implementation, compliance and accountability.

Where planning is absent, the consequences are evident: insecurity of public land tenure, uncoordinated and unsustainable development, encroachment on public land, degradation of ecologically fragile areas, and persistent challenges in the registration, protection and optimal utilization of public land.

Ajira 14,000 za ubaharia kwa Wakenya ugenini zaja

Mamlaka ya Usimamizi wa Masuala ya Bahari Kenya (KMA) imesaini makubaliano ya utambuzi na mataifa manne katika juhudi kubwa za kupanua fursa za ajira kwa mabaharia wa Kenya, hatua inayotarajiwa kuzalisha zaidi ya nafasi 14,000 za kazi kwenye meli za kimataifa. Makubaliano hayo, yaliyotiwa saina na Singapore, Jamhuri ya Dominika, Ufalme wa Saudi Arabia na Jamhuri ya Korea, yanalenga kuimarisha ushindani wa mabaharia wa Kenya katika soko la kimataifa huku yakiongeza mapato ya nchi kupitia fedha zinazotumwa nyumbani na Wakenya wanaofanya kazi nje ya nchi. Akizungumza wakati wa Kongamano la Uhama-sishaji kwa Makadeti lililofanyika Mombasa, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KMA, CPA Omai Nyarandi, alisema mamlaka hiyo imejizatiti kuifanya Kenya kuwa miongoni mwa nchi zinazoongoza kwa kutoa wataalamu wenye ujuzi katika sekta ya usafiri wa baharini duniani. Nyarandi alisema

makubaliano hayo yatawapa mabaharia wa Kenya fursa ya kupata ajira katika meli za kimataifa huku yakiongeza ushiriki wa nchi katika uchumi wa bahari wa kimataifa. “Makubaliano tuliyotia saina yataunda mustakabali wa sekta ya bahari kwa mabaharia na makadeti wetu kwa kuwafungulia milango ya fursa za kimataifa,” alisema. Alifichua kuwa KMA pia inaendelea kushirikiana na wadau wengine wa kimataifa kwa lengo la kupata nafasi zaidi za ajira kwa mabaharia wa Kenya na wahitimu wa masomo ya bahari. Mkurugenzi Mkuu huyo pia alitangaza kuwa mamlaka hiyo imetoa kandarasi ya kutengeneza na kusambaza Hati za Utambulisho wa Mabaharia (Seafarers' Identity Documents - SID), ambazo ni hitaji muhimu kwa mabaharia wanaotafuta ajira nje ya nchi. Kwa mujibu wa Nyarandi, mkandarasi anatarajiwa kukamilisha kazi hiyo ndani ya miezi miwili kabla ya sampuli ya hati ya SID kuwasilishwa kwa Shirika la Kazi Duniani (ILO) kwa ajili ya uhakiki na idhini.

Miundombinu ya oksijeni yapigwa jeki hospitalini

Gavana wa Machakos, Wavinya Ndeti, amezindua mfumo mpya wa mabomba ya kusambaza oksijeni ya matibabu, mfumo wa usambazaji wa oksijeni (oxygen manifold), pamoja na miundombinu iliyobore-shwa ya usambazaji wa maji na mifereji ya maji taka katika Kituo cha Afya cha Muumandu, Wadi ya Kola. Alizindua miradi hiyo wakati wa hatua ya mwisho ya ziara yake ya maendeleo katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Machakos, inayolenga kuboresha utoaji wa huduma na kuhakikisha vituo vya afya vinaafiki viwango vya kisasa vya huduma za afya. Mfumo wa mabomba ya oksijeni na oxygen manifold utahakikisha upatikanaji wa oksijeni ya matibabu bila kukatizwa katika wodi na vitengo vya dharura, huku mabore-sho ya mfumo wa maji na mifereji yakitarajiwa kuimarisha udhibiti wa maambukizi na usafi katika

kituo hicho. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo, Gavana Ndeti alisema miundombinu hiyo imewekwa ili kuhakikisha vituo vya afya vinaendelea kutoa huduma bila kukatizwa, hasa wakati wa dharura. Alisisitiza kuwa mfumo wa uhakika ya oksijeni na maji ni sehemu muhimu ya huduma bora za afya na inapaswa kupewa kipaumbele katika vituo vyote vya afya vya umma. “Kila kituo cha afya lazima kiwe tayari kukabiliana na dharura. Miundombinu ya msingi kama mfumo wa oksijeni na maji si jambo la hiari linapokuja suala la kuokoa maisha,” alisema. Kituo cha Afya cha Muumandu kinahudumia wakazi wa Wadi ya Kola na maeneo ya jirani. Kupitia mabore-sho hayo, wahudumu wa afya sasa wana uwezo mkubwa zaidi wa kushughulikia magonjwa ya mfumo wa upumuaji, dharura za uzazi na rufaa za upasuaji kwa ufanisi na usalama zaidi.
